Michigan has already secured the No. 1 seed as it has won the Big Ten regular season title outright.

NO. 3 SEED: MICHIGAN STATE, WISCONSIN
Michigan State clinches with:

- Loss OR Wisconsin win

Wisconsin clinches with:

- loss AND Michigan State win

NO. 4 SEED: IOWA, NEBRASKA, OHIO STATE
Iowa clinches with:

- win AND Nebraska loss
*Iowa holds head-to-head tiebreaker at 10-8 with Nebraska and holds potential 3-way tiebreaker at 10-8 with Nebraska and Ohio State due to having best combined win percentage head-tohead (Iowa 2-1; Ohio State 2-2; Nebraska 1-2)

Nebraska clinches with:

- win
- loss AND Iowa loss AND Ohio State loss

Ohio State clinches with:

- win AND Iowa loss AND Nebraska loss
*Ohio State holds head-to-head tiebreaker at 10-8 with Nebraska due to having a better win percentage against Wisconsin

NO. 5 SEED: IOWA, NEBRASKA, OHIO STATE
Iowa clinches with:

- win AND Nebraska win
- loss AND Ohio State loss
*Iowa holds head-to-head tiebreakers at 10-8 and 9-9 with Ohio State due to better win percentage against Michigan

Nebraska clinches with:

- loss AND Iowa win AND Ohio State loss
- loss AND Iowa loss AND Ohio State win

Ohio State clinches with:

- win AND Iowa win AND Nebraska loss
- win AND Iowa loss AND Nebraska win

NO. 6 SEED: IOWA, NEBRASKA, OHIO STATE
Iowa clinches with:

- loss AND Ohio State win

Nebraska clinches with:

- loss AND Iowa win AND Ohio State win

Ohio State clinches with:

- win AND Iowa win AND Nebraska win
- loss


## NO. 7 SEED: ILLINOIS, INDIANA, MINNESOTA

Illinois clinches with:

- win AND Indiana loss AND Minnesota loss
*Illinois holds 4-way tiebreaker at 7-11 with Indiana, Minnesota and Penn State due to best combined win percentage head-to-head (Illinois 4-1; Minnesota 2-2; Indiana 2-3; Penn State 2-4)

Indiana clinches with:

- win AND Minnesota loss

Minnesota clinches with:

- win
- loss AND Indiana loss AND Illinois loss
*Minnesota holds head-to-head tiebreaker at 8-10 with Indiana and holds 3-way tiebreaker at 7-11 with Indiana and Penn State due to best combined win percentage head-to-head (Minnesota 2-1; Penn State 2-2; Indiana 1-2)

NO. 8 SEED: ILLINOIS, INDIANA, MINNESOTA, PENN STATE Illinois clinches with:

- win AND Indiana win AND Minnesota loss
*Illinois holds 3-way tiebreaker at 7-11 with Minnesota and Penn State due to best combined win percentage head-to-head (Illinois 3-0; Minnesota 1-2; Penn State 1-3)


## Indiana clinches with:

- Minnesota win
*Indiana holds potential head-to-head tiebreaker at 7-11 with Illinois due to better win percentage against Michigan

Minnesota clinches with:

- loss AND Indiana loss AND Illinois win
- loss AND Indiana win AND Illinois loss
*Minnesota holds head-to-head tiebreaker at 7-11 with Penn State due to a better win percentage against Wisconsin, regardless of where Wisconsin finishes in the standings


## Penn State clinches with:

- win AND Indiana loss AND Illinois loss

NO. 9 SEED: ILLINOIS, INDIANA, MINNESOTA, PENN STATE
Illinois clinches with:

- Minnesota win
*Illinois holds potential 3-way tiebreaker at 6-12 with Northwestern and Penn State due to best combined win percentage (Illinois 2-1; Northwestern 1-1; Penn State 1-2); Illinois also holds potential 3-way tiebreaker at 6-12 with Penn State and Purdue (Illinois 2-1; Purdue 2-1; Penn State 1-3; Illinois would win next tiebreaker over Purdue due to better win percentage against Michigan State, regardless of where Michigan State finishes in the standings)

Indiana clinches with:

- loss AND Minnesota loss


## Minnesota clinches with:

- loss AND Indiana win AND Illinois win

Penn State clinches with:

- win AND Indiana win AND Illinois loss

NO. 10 SEED: NORTHWESTERN, PENN STATE, PURDUE
Northwestern clinches with:

- win AND Illinois loss
*Northwestern holds potential head-to-head tiebreaker at 6-12 with Illinois

Penn State clinches with:

- Illinois win
*Penn State holds potential head-to-head tiebreaker at 6-12 with Northwestern and holds potential head-to-head tiebreaker at 6-12 with Purdue due to better combined win percentage against Ohio State, regardless of where Ohio State finishes in the standings

Purdue clinches with:

- win AND Illinois loss
*Purdue holds potential head-to-head tiebreaker at 6-12 with Illinois

Illinois clinches with:

- loss AND Penn State win

Northwestern clinches with:

- win AND Illinois win
