Wallace hired as new recruiting coordinator

Iowa has named Seth Wallace as its new football recruiting coordinator, head coach Kirk Ferentz announced in a release sent Thursday afternoon. The hiring of Wallace was first reported Thursday by FootballScoop.com.
